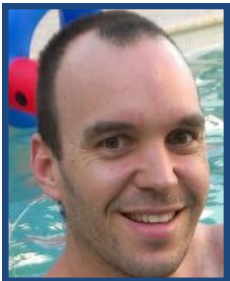
AUGUST 2013 NEWSLETTER

Get your thinking caps on and let's have a barrel of laughs!

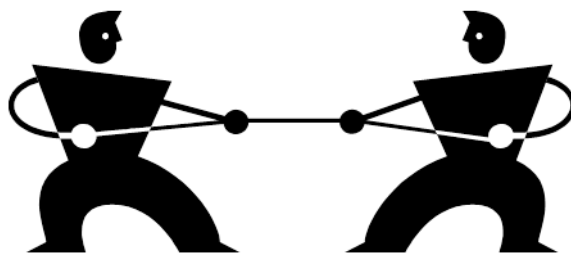


INTERCLUB CHALLENGE
