What a talented bunch we are! There were so many acts and the laughs went on for hours and hours.

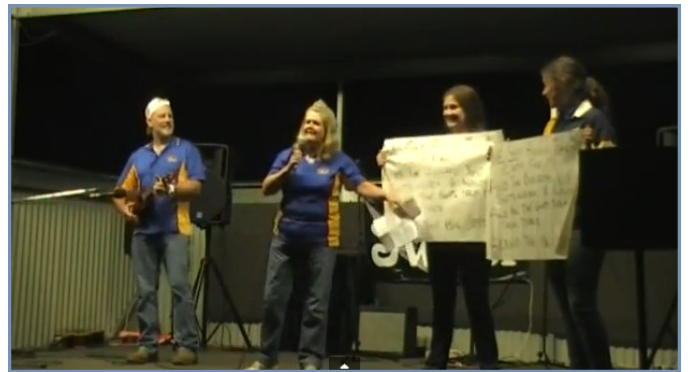
The judges awarded first place to the North Boys from the North Coast 4x4 Club for their high energy dance routine (which was rather eye opening for those in the front rows!)
