Track Update

The team from the North Coast 4x4 Club are now finalising all the tracks to be used over the Corroboree weekend. Some of the tracks were found months ago so we've been revisiting and maintaining them. The land managers, HQ Plantations and Qld Parks and Wildlife Service, have also been kept up to date with the areas we will be traversing over the weekend.



What is evident on some tracks is the pretty but nasty Lantana. Lantana is a large flowering shrub native to Central and Sth America and was brought into Australia in 1851 as an ornamental plant.



Unfortunately it's done a truly impressive job of invading the country and is now declared an environmental threat to native species. See those sharp, pointy bits? They do an excellent job of scratching paintwork. Our club

has tried to avoid or cut back the worst areas but it's a hard-to-tame beast. You've been warned!

Acts can consist of 1 or more persons, with your act lasting around 5 minutes.


The North Coast 4x4 Club will get the ball rolling with 1 or more of our members performing a ditty.
